	Note: Tolvaptan Lupin 15 mg tablet blister pack & Tolvaptan Lupin 30 mg tablet blister pack are not marketed.	
Indications:	Tolvaptan Lupin is indicated to slow the progression of cyst development and renal insufficiency of autosomal dominant polycystic kidney disease (ADPKD) in adults with chronic kidney disease (CKD) stage 1 to 3 at initiation of treatment with evidence of rapidly progressing disease.	

Generic Health Pty Ltd wish to provide you with the following important safety risks associated with Tolvaptan therapy:

- Tolvaptan has been associated with idiosyncratic elevations of blood alanine and aspartate aminotransferases (ALT and AST), rarely associated with concomitant elevations in bilirubin-total (BT). To help mitigate the risk of liver injury, blood testing for hepatic transaminases is required prior to initiation of Tolvaptan Lupin, then continually monthly for 18 months, then every 3 months thereafter during treatment with Tolvaptan Lupin (see Section 4.4 Special Warnings and Precautions for Use in the full Product Information).
- Prescriber education and certification on the risk of liver injury and the importance of regular liver function monitoring is mandatory.
